Supply List for 2016-2017

****Please label all supplies with child's name (including each crayon and pencil)****

1. Book bag/back pack large enough to hold folder without bending it.(**no wheels**)
2. A 2-pocket folder with pockets on the bottom, not the side – vinyl is best!
3. An old adult t-shirt with short sleeves to use as a paint shirt. (please print in large black marker across the back the child's name)
4. Plastic school box – **must fit in 8 X 11 cubby** – (a plastic Sterilite brand container 2.7 qt. size w/plastic snap handles works great.)
5. **Elmer's** School glue – do not buy dripless as it clogs too easily
6. **Fiskars** Scissors with metal pointed blades
7. **Crayola** crayons with basic 8 colors plus gray and pink – **No Rose Art** please!
8. 4 sharpened pencils with erasers
9. 1 large pink eraser
10. 1 box of colored pencils – **CRAYOLA ONLY**
11. 6 **LARGE** glue sticks – small ones are finished in no time and often break easily
12. One container of baby wipes, girls one box of gallon Ziploc bags, boys one box quart Ziploc bags and all bring one box of tissues now and I after Christmas..
13. One large snack and one **large 100% juice** for the entire class now and then we will ask for another each of the 4 quarters. Suggestions: Crackers, pretzels, individual servings of fruit, yogurt, Oreos, Goldfish or other low sugar snacks. We would always welcome fresh fruit, veggies or cheese that is ready to be served and perhaps a heads up on the day you will be willing to bring!
14. 2 x 100 count Dixie cups & 1 x 500 standard size napkins
15. Class Fee \$60.00 payable to St. Michael School. (Includes T shirt)
16. Water color paints

While this list appears to be very stringent in product brands, we have tested many of the glues, scissors, crayons and markers. Some do not last, others do not work and some are not the basic colors needed as in the case of Rose Art. We suggest you carry this supply list in your purse and look for the sales through out the summer. We know for a fact that Staples, Wal-mart and other stores will offer discounts on the items. The eraser and scissors should last several years. The folder will probably need replaced mid year so you might want to get two now. The heavier ones work the best to protect the precious papers your child will be bringing home. Names on the supplies allow lost items to be returned. Yes, each pencil & crayon!
